

North Kyme Parish Council Meeting Minutes

003/04/2025 ~ Heritage fund ~ The gates at either end of the village need to have flower boxes on them when we purchase them.

There will be gates put at each entrance to the village.

Cllr Taylor requested a sub committee for the Heritage fund.

02/03/2025 ~ Village hall Donation – The green gates at the entrance of the car park – The gates need to be sand blasted and painted. Cllr Melbourne expressed his concern with regards to the a serious state of the gates and that it needs sand blasting. District Cllr Whittle stated there was a company outside Nottingham that uses acid to strip the paint. Clerk to investigate. and get quotes

009/08/2025 ~ Cllr Volunteers Service – They will do the painting for the play park if we supply paint, brushes pots etc and find out who the manufacturer of the play park equipment is to make sure we are putting the right paint on the equipment. Cllr Everard said the company that supplied the equipment was, "Play daze". Clerk to make contact and find out.

005/04/2025 ~ South Kyme Parish Council have now put in writing that the Shared Sid is now solely ours. The batteries are flat so Cllr Melbourne will contact Mr Pout who has the key once he returns to the country.
