**001/06/2026 - 1. Chairmans Opening Address** - The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.

**002/06/2026 - 2. Co-Option of Mr. Limb** - Mr. Limb told the council why he would like to be a Councillor and he was duly co-opted onto the Council, Mr. Limb is now Cllr Shane Limb proposed, seconded, and resolved.

**003/06/2026 3. Apologies for absence and acceptance of any reasons given** – None

**004/06/2026 - 2. Declarations of Interest- Cllrs must declare interests in planning or any items on the agenda.** None were declared.

**005/06/2026 - 3. Updates from District Cllr:** - Local Government organisation – the restructuring of the Councils within in Lincoln It is going to Parliament on the 15<sup>th</sup> of July North Kyme could be in Rural Lincolnshire.

Also have figures for the shed the council would like to be built.

Option one is a 10m x 5m wooden building which would cost between £12,500 to £15,000.

Option 2 – is a 10m x 10m wooden building which would cost £25,000 to £30,000.

Option 3 – A brick building £100,000 - £150,000.

Cllr Taylor stated that there will be gates put at each entrance to the village. The Chair asked for a vote regarding the gates six councillors voted against it. It was proposed seconded and resolved that the white gates discussed previously will not be in the heritage fund application. Cllr Taylor did not agree with this and suggestion a petition be raised Cllr Rue asked Cllr Taylor if this was as a private citizen or Parish Councillor. Cllr Taylor decided not to go ahead with the petition.

Cllr Taylor requested a subcommittee for the Heritage fund. Those on the sub-committee will now be Cllr Rue, Cllr Taylor and Cllr O'Doherty Carolyn Barber Graham Melbourne and Darren Taylor and Cat Cunningham.

**006/06/2026** - Cllr Spry stated that it was raised on Facebook the other day that the taxi drivers that are staying at the bed and breakfast are parking on people's verges and blocking people in. Cllr A Rue is going to have a word with the relevant people.

Cllr Spry also raised if the children could have their bus passes on their phones as the children are losing the passes all the time and it costs £5.00 for each new card.
