Welcome to your November & Christmas village newsletter.

As normal the Parish Council has been meeting regularly to discuss finances and projects planned for our village. A topic that is habitually on the agenda is speeding through the village. The parish had set aside funds to fund a community speed watch group. In order to sustain the project we required at least 12 volunteers. Unfortunately after asking over the last 18 months we could not muster enough team members to make it viable. (Thanks to those who did volunteer). The Speed watch ring-fenced funds have been redirected into a fund to purchase a permanent speed indicator device as well as updating our existing SID which is unserviceable at present. Through this money as well as various events in the village that have also contributed, we are more than halfway to our target. One fantastic leap forward in village road safety is that the children who used to wait for the bus on the narrow pavement adjacent to the van sales yard are now able to catch the bus on the opposite side of the road next to the bus shelter. Talking of bus shelters, that too is on our hit list and will be getting a long-awaited makeover.

We have two events coming up in the village that are always very well attended. We will be holding a small act of remembrance in the church yard on Sunday 13th November at 11 AM. Following in December will be the annual Christmas lights switch on. We hope to see as many people as possible to join us at this great family event. 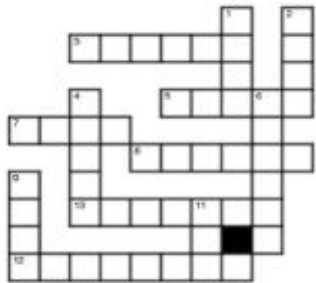
